



## Intro to Kayak Fishing Part 2 Guided Fishing Trip

Description: Day 2 will consist of a full day on the water learning about the tides and underwater terrain of Steinhatchee, Florida. Each angler will also be taught the use of live bait and artificial lures to target such species as red drum (redfish), spotted seatrout and summer flounder. FHKC's goal is that each angler leave this 2 day event with an increased knowledge of fishing knots, rigging tackle, reading tides and predicting weather along with the confidence to fish any location while targeting the more popular species using artificial lures.

Paddle Distance/Time: N/A /8:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Paddle Skill Level: Novice

Location/Launch: Rocky Creek Boat Ramp. Take CR 361 south out of Jena, continue about 5.6 miles from Casey's Cove Convenience Store to Rocky Creek Road on your right. Follow that road to the ramp.

Minimum Kayak Size Requirement: None

Each angler will need to bring the following:

1 or 2 medium action 6.5 to 7 ft rod(s) with spinning reel spooled with 10-15 pound test braid line.

1 Weighted Popping Cork / with a wire thru it.

000 Circle hooks

Brands: Cajun Thunder , DOA Lures also makes one. They can be found at any local tackle shop or box store. Shrimp will be provided. We will also have all types of artificial lures for those who wish to learn those techniques.

PFDs are required to be worn when on the water.
