

Pine Log Creek North Loop

Description: Launch from the Pine Log ramp and paddle out Pine Log Creek to the Gulf, where you turn north briefly along the coast to Porpoise Creek. From there, continue up Porpoise Creek and hang a right, heading back To Pine Log Creek ramp. Navigation can be difficult due to all the side creeks. Should only be paddled on medium to high tide.

Distance/Time: 2.8 Miles/ 1.5 Hours

Skill Level: Novice/Intermediate

Indigenous Wildlife: Eagles, ospreys, various shore-birds and waterfowl, mullet, redfish, spotted sea trout, bottle-nosed dolphins, raccoons, scallops, and blue crabs.

Launch Site: Take CR 361 south out of Jena, continue about .9 miles from Casey's Cove Convenience Store, take a right, then your first left. Continue on that road to the Pine Log Launch are at the end of the road.

NOTE: Great care has been taken to ensure this guides accuracy, but weather, tides, and water conditions can change rapidly and create hazardous conditions. Routes may change due to weather considerations. Users should consult NOAA Charts for navigation. Paddlers should have all proper safety equipment and check conditions before departure. All participants are required to wear PFDs while on water based events .
