

Pine Log Creek South Paddle

Description: Launch from Pine Log Ramp and paddle out Pine Log Creek to the Gulf. Pass Pine Log Island on your right and Howard Creek on your left and enter the next Creek. From there, it follows a winding creek through the salt marsh and small island hammocks back to Pine Log. Navigation can be difficult due to the large number of side creeks. Should only be paddled on medium to high tide.

Distance/Time: 2.5 Miles/ 1.5 Hours

Skill Level: Novice/Intermediate

Indigenous Wildlife: Eagles, ospreys, various shorebirds and waterfowl, mullet, redfish, spotted sea trout, bottle-nosed dolphins, raccoons, scallops, and blue crabs.

Launch Site: Take CR 361 south out of Jena, continue about .9 miles from Casey's Cove Convenience Store, take a right, then your first left. Continue on that road to the Pine Log Launch are at the end of the road.

NOTE: Great care has been taken to ensure this guides accuracy, but weather, tides, and water conditions can change rapidly and create hazardous conditions. Routes may change due to weather considerations. Users should consult NOAA Charts for navigation. Paddlers should have all proper safety equipment and check conditions before departure. All participants are required to wear PFDs while on water based events .
