

Rocky Creek/Sink Creek Paddle

Description: Launch from Rocky Creek and paddle about 5 miles to Sink Creek, one of the most remote and scenic campsites on the Big Bend Saltwater Paddling Trail. This is an enticing, shady picnic destination. A short hike reveals an eerie landscape of skeletal trees, perfect for black & white photography. We will also visit the freshwater spring boil a short paddle upstream from the campsite., then return to Rocky Creek.

Skill Level: Advanced

Indigenous Wildlife: Eagles, ospreys, various shorebirds and waterfowl, mullet, redfish, spotted sea trout, bottle-nosed dolphins, raccoons, scallops, and blue crabs.

Launch Site: Take CR 361 south out of Jena, continue about 5.6 miles from Casey's Cove Convenience Store to Rocky Creek Road on your right. Follow that road to the ramp.

NOTE: Great care has been taken to ensure this guides accuracy, but weather, tides, and water conditions can change rapidly and create hazardous conditions. Routes may change due to weather considerations. Users should consult NOAA Charts for navigation. Paddlers should have all proper safety equipment and check conditions before departure. All participants are required to wear PFDs while on water based events .
