Description: This beautiful property features salt marsh, pine flatwoods and mixed hammocks of hardwoods, cedars and palms, plus tidal ponds and creeks. We'll take a slow walk along the Yellow Fishing Pier Trail looking for Yellow-crowned Night Herons, Clapper Rails and Ospreys. We'll also be on the lookout for migrating songbirds such as American Redstart and resident songbirds such as Eastern Towhee. The preserve provides haven for many species of butterfly too so we'll be on the look out for them as well.
