

Bennetts Creek Loop

Description: Launch at Bird Park and we'll head toward East Pass and up Bennetts Creek, which opens back into the Withlacoochee for our paddle back. This is a great creek for birding and observing wildlife, so bring your binoculars and camera.

Skill Level: Novice/Intermediate

Minimum Boat Size: Canoe or Kayak 12'

Distance/Time: 6.4 Miles/3 Hours

Indigenous Wildlife: Eagles, Ospreys, Spoonbills, Wood Storks, various shorebirds and waterfowl, wild hogs, mullet, raccoons, and otters.

Launch Site: Bird Park on the right at the end of CR 40

NOTE: Great care has been taken to ensure this guides accuracy, but weather, tides, and water conditions can change rapidly and create hazardous conditions. Routes may change due to weather considerations. Users should consult NOAA Charts for navigation. Paddlers should have all proper safety equipment and check conditions before departure. All participants are required to wear PFDs while on water based events .
