

Bird Creek Loop

Description: Launch at Bird Park and paddle a short distance up the Withlacoochee, where we'll enter Bird Creek and wind through the small cedar hammocks and under the HWY 40 Bridge. From there it will be a short trip along the coast back to the park.

Skill Level: Novice

Minimum Kayak Size: 12'

Distance/Time: 3 Miles/1 1/2 Hours

Indigenous Wildlife: Eagles, ospreys, various shorebirds and waterfowl, mullet, redfish, spotted sea trout, raccoons, and blue crabs.

Launch Site: Bird Park on right at end of CR 40.

NOTE: Great care has been taken to ensure this guides accuracy, but weather, tides, and water conditions can change rapidly and create hazardous conditions. Routes may change due to weather considerations. Users should consult NOAA Charts for navigation. Paddlers should have all proper safety equipment and check conditions before departure. All participants are required to wear PFDs while on water based events .
