

Felburn Park—Dam Paddle

Description: Launch from the HWY 19/Barge Canal ramp at Felburn Park and we'll paddle up the Barge Canal to the Withlacoochee River, then another mile and a half to the Inglis Dam. Current in the river section will depend on recent rainfall.

Skill Level: Novice/Intermediate

Minimum Boat Size: Canoe or Kayak 12'

Distance/Time: 6.2 Miles/3 Hours

Indigenous Wildlife: Eagles, ospreys, various shorebirds and waterfowl, mullet, redfish, spotted sea trout, raccoons, otters, and blue crabs.

Launch Site: Felburn Park . Ramp is at the southeast corner of HWY 19 and the Barge Canal
