

WACCASASSA RIVER TRAIL

Description: This paddle starts at the end of CR 326 and proceeds down river to a circumnavigation of Stafford's Island, and back to the ramp. Typical plant habitat is hydric hammock area with a transition to salt marsh as you get closer to the Gulf.

Distance/Time: 5.3 Miles/Approximately 3 Hours

Skill Level: Intermediate due to moderate current flow and boat traffic.

Minimum Boat Size: Canoe or Kayak, No size restriction

Indigenous Wildlife: Common sights along the river are alligators, manatees, ospreys and other local wildlife.

Launch Site: Turn west off HWY 19 on to CR 326. Proceed down to the boat ramp at the end of the road.

NOTE: Great care has been taken to ensure this guides accuracy, but weather, tides, and water conditions can change rapidly and create hazardous conditions. Route may change due to weather considerations. Users should have all proper safety equipment and check conditions before departure. All participants are required to wear PFDs while on water based events.
